Students embraced the opportunity to learn about their own wellbeing, how to support those around them and how to access support for themselves. Our very own Mental Health Ambassador's also manned a stall to raise awareness and share information about the fantastic peer mentoring programme we offer at CoPA.



Staff received advice on how to support young people and talk about mental health.
