Dear Students and Parents/Carers,

RE: Leaver's Assembly and Year 11 Prom

Leavers Day 21 June 2024

Our leavers day celebration takes place this coming Friday. We ask students to arrive at the Academy at 11.30am in uniform through the year 11 main entrance. Students will congregate on the music courtyard before being invited into the main hall for the assembly. We do insist that students hand in their mobile phones for this aspect of the leavers day celebration they will be returned to students after the assembly to allow them to take pictures with their peers.
