Firstly, I would like to wish you all a Happy New Year. I trust you all had a good Christmas break. It has been great to see the CoPA community back for the Spring Term where we continue to move the school forward to bigger and better things.

Equipment

I presented an assembly on Tuesday explaining to students that as a GOOD school we would expect students to bring a basic set of equipment to school. Thousands of pounds have historically been wasted by providing students with pens and other learning equipment. This is money that we would like to invest in continuing to make CoPA better for everyone.

From Monday, form tutors will be checking that students have the basic equipment required each morning. Students will be required to purchase equipment from the school shop if they do not have it using their Class Charts points.

Please could I ask that you support us by encouraging your child to bring a bag to school containing the basic equipment they need for learning. If families require support in doing this, please ensure you contact your child's Head of Year.


